PERMIT PROVISIONS AND CONDITIONS OF ISSUANCE

Pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes and City Code of Ordinances s.13.10, this permit is granted to allow performance of the specific work described herein. The following standard provisions, any included special provisions, and provisions in Section 13.10 that are not specified below shall govern:

1. The Applicant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Eau Claire, its employees and its agents, from any cost, claim, suit, liability and/or award which might come, be brought, or be assessed, because of the issuance or exercise of this permit, or because of any adverse effect upon any person or property which is attributed to the partially or entirely completed works of the Applicant. Accomplishment of the permitted work, or any part thereof, by or on behalf of the Applicant shall bind such Applicant to abide by this permit and all its conditions and provisions.
2. The permitted facilities shall, if necessary, be altered at the expense of the Applicant to permit alteration, improvement, or maintenance of the street as may hereafter be ordered. The entire cost of constructing and maintaining the permitted facilities shall be the obligation of the Applicant unless a contract for such costs has been executed.
3. No open cutting for a crossing will be allowed where the pavement is too narrow to maintain one-way traffic at all times, unless the City has granted permission for a detour. Wherever the pavement is opened, the excavation shall be backfilled with approved materials and mechanically compacted in twelve-inch (12") layers, and shall be left flush with the existing surface. The pavement removed for a road crossing shall be replaced as per the City specifications.
4. All bituminous pavement shall be straight-edged with an air hammer and blade or saw cut and all concrete pavement shall be saw cut. All surface material and unsuitable excavated material shall be removed from the site. Excavated material shall be placed to permit the free flow of surface water along the gutter.
5. When one-way traffic or a detour is used, the Applicant shall provide ALL NECESSARY SIGNS, FLAGMEN AND LIGHTS required according to the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices". If the excavation requires closing the street, the Public Works Department must be notified twenty-four (24) hours prior to the closing by calling 839-4934. Detour routes are to be approved by the department before permission is granted. All barricades and detour signs shall be furnished and maintained by the Permittee.
6. All disturbed areas shall be returned to their present condition or better within ten (10) days, subject to the satisfaction of the City or its representative. Access to all private drives and public street intersections shall be maintained, and all disturbed areas completely restored.
7. Any trenching, tunneling, or excavating shall be performed in accordance with the requirements of OSHA and the Wisconsin Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations, and any applicable local regulations.
8. A copy of this approval, along with any plans and special provisions, shall be available on the job site.
9. Upon completion of the work, the Applicant shall file a written notice with the City.
10. The Applicant shall guarantee the backfilling and compaction for two (2) years. If settlement or failure occurs, repairs shall be made at the Applicant's expense.
11. DIGGERSHOTLINE (1-800-242-8511) shall be notified of the proposed excavation a minimum of three (3) days prior to the start of work.
