Narrative:

At 23:16 hours the Eau Claire Fire Department was dispatched to a structure fire at 644 Putnam Street. Engine 10 arrived on scene at 23:19 and found the single family wood frame structure at 644 Putnam Street fully involved. Fire was extending to 642 Putnam as well. A second alarm was struck.

The house at 644 Putnam was vacant at the time of the fire and was being remodeled. The structure to the south of this home is 642 Putnam and this is a single family occupied structure.

Engine 10 pulled attack lines and a water supply was established. Additional units assisted with extinguishing the fire in 642 Putnam Street, however, the home at 644 was a total loss. 642 Putnam suffered severe fire and water damage and damage is estimated at \$45,000 on the structure and \$35,000 on the contents. This property is assessed at \$81,000.

The cause of the fire is unknown at this time and ECPD remains on the scene until the investigation resumes this morning. One firefighter suffered a second degree burn to the back of the hand. He was treated at the scene for the burn and did not require transport to a hospital. There were no other injuries.
