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Narrative:

The ECFD responded to a report of a structure fire. An update from onsite personnel indicated flames showing. A second alarm was called. Upon arrival the Engine crews made an interior attack to knock down the fire. The interior attack was unsuccessful and the crews were ordered out of the building and the fire was fought from the exterior. The building had been remodel several times and the void spaces in the roof line made fighting the fire difficult. After the bulk of the fire was knocked down the crews spent multiple hours locating and extinguishing the small fires in the in the attic space. As of the time of this report crews were still on scene.

I FF was injured but was not transported, he was treated on scene.

The fire is currently under investigation.
The building will probably be a total loss.
