### **Narrative:**

The fire department was dispatched to a structure fire at the above address. The initial report was a garage on fire that is attached to a four-plex apartment. Crews arrived on scene to find heavy fire coming from the garage and smoke coming from the apartment it was attached to. The occupant heard a popping noise in the garage. She then opened the door and noted fire and smoke in the garage. The occupant of the apartment had evacuated and was outside prior to our arrival. Crews on scene extinguished the fire and kept the fire from going inside the residence. An occupant from another apartment was evacuated for safety. Fire crews made a quick stop and the fire was marked control in less than thirty minutes. The fire remains under investigation.
