**Narrative:**

The Eau Claire Fire Department Responded to a report of a structure fire at 3014 6th St.

When Firefighters arrive they found dark smoke with flames shooting out of a one story wood frame home with a tuck under garage.

There were two occupants and one dog in the home at the time of the fire. The occupants were alerted and awakened by a smoke detector in the home and were able to exit the home with their dog before firefighters arrived.

A second alarm was call and firefighters used a defensive attack with hose lines and an aerial ladder to put the fire out. The fire was under control in about two hours with fighters on the scene to check hot spots and to investigate the cause of the fire.

The occupants are staying with relatives for now.
