### **Narrative:**

ECFD crews were dispatched to a structure fire at 514 N. Barstow St. just before 03:00 a.m. this morning. The initial report was occupants were still trapped in the building. When units arrived on scene they found heavy smoke and some flames coming from the second floor of a four-plex apartment building. Crews focused efforts on evacuation of the building and rescue of a missing occupant. Crews located a victim on the second floor. The victim was transported to Mayo Hospital EC and was later pronounced dead. Crews continued to extinguish the fire. The fire was marked under control at approximately 0430 hrs. Fire crews remain on scene. ECFD Fire Inspectors and the State Fire Marshal's Office are investigating.
