2. Report and Consideration on a Resolution Regarding Proposal for Programming Relationship with SNAP-ED / WNEP

Mr. Johnathan reported that the University of Wisconsin Extension is seeking an arrangement to conduct educational lessons to residents of Park Tower Apartments and Owen Rust Memorial Apartments for their fiscal year 2016 which starts October 2015. The Housing Authority would incur a minimal cost relating to duplicating and samples.

3. Report and Consideration on a Resolution Regarding Affordable Housing Rent Increases

Mr. Johnathan reported that Affordable Housing rents have not been increased since 2011. The formula in figuring the rent increases was the same as Public Housing's flat rent increases. The new rents are set to 80% of the Fair Market Rents (FMRs) (as determined by HUD), but are not to exceed a 35% increase. The rents would be effective starting July 1, 2015.

4. Report and Consideration on a Resolution Regarding Public Housing Ceiling / Flat Rent Increases

Mr. Johnathan reported that the Public Housing ceiling / flat rent is annually reviewed and adjusted. These rent increases would be effective June 1, 2015.

Mr. Johnathan reported that items # 6 and 7 were similar. The only difference is that the Transitional Housing Program is eliminating the washer and dryer appliances as the cost of repairs is high and when these appliances break down, they will then be removed from the units and no longer provided. The similarities are revisions to incorporate local and state statute references for smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors. For fires / open flames, the change is to not allow candles in the units.
