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Narrative:

Eau Claire Fire Department was dispatched to a possible structure fire at 4115 Paula Place. When Firefighters arrived they found light smoke coming from the eaves of a one story duplex home. All the occupants of both residents had exited the home.

When Firefighters investigated they found a fire in the attic of the home and the fire was now coming through the roof on the back of the duplex. A second alarm was called for additional firefighters and equipment. Township Fire along with Altoona Fire manned their stations.

The fire was put under control quickly by firefighters.

Damage was mostly contained to the one residents but two families were displaced. The Red Cross assisted with shelter for one family and the second family was staying with relatives.
