Narrative:

The Eau Claire Fire Department was dispatched to a structure fire at 420 Franklin St. at 11:03 am today.

When Firefighters arrived we found a two story multi-family home with heavy smoke coming from the eaves of the roof. Several of the occupants were out in the front yard of the home when firefighters arrived.

A second alarm fire response was called for as firefighters made an aggressive fire attack into the second floor of the building. Firefighters encountered extreme heat and zero visibility on the second floor and were forced back out of the building.

Firefighters fought the fire for more than an hour before bringing it under control.

No one was injured in the fire, but 7 people were displaced by the fire. The American Red Cross is assisting with temporary shelter several of the occupants.

Altoona, Township and the Chippewa Fire Protection District assisted the Eau Claire Fire Department with staffing stations.
