### **Narrative:**

ECFD units were dispatched to possible structure fire with smoke in the attic. When fire units arrived on scene they found light to moderate smoke in the attic of a side by side single story duplex. The occupants on one side of the duplex had a cooking fire on the stove this afternoon about 3:00 pm. The occupants thought they had it out. It was found to have spread to the attic and noticed by occupants several hours later about 9:36pm. Fire crews rapidly extinguished the fire. Fire units remained on scene for about 2 hours.
