Narrative:

Just After 3:00 pm. on Friday 12/18/15 the Eau Claire Fire Department responded to a structure fire at 420 Franklin St. in Eau Claire.

Firefighters arrived within 3 minutes of the call to find flames and dark smoke coming from the first floor of an unoccupied home that had been destroyed by fire on October 23, of this year.

No one was in the burned out building and it was scheduled to be demolished next week.

It took firefighters about 30 minutes to get the fire under control.

One firefighter suffered a minor injury from falling debris while fighting the fire.

The cause of the fire is under investigation by the Eau Claire Police and Fire Departments.
