### **Narrative:**

The ECFD responded to a report of a structure fire. Upon arrival there was a report of victims trapped in the building. Smoke and fire was showing from the building and the first in Engine deployed an 1.75" hose line to attempt to knock the fire down and search the building. 2 occupants escaped and 2 victims were removed from the building by ECFD Fire Fighters. Both were transported to Mayo Eau Claire by Paramedic Ambulance. Of the two victims transported, one is a fatality and the other was airlifted to Hennepin County Medical Center. The fire is currently under investigation by the ECFD and the ECPD. At the time of this release Engines crews are still on scene performing overhaul and checking for fire extension.
