### **Narrative:**

Eau Claire Fire and Rescue was dispatched to a structure fire in a business on Eau Claire's south side. The structure is owned and operated by Phillips Plastics of Eau Claire. Engine 5 arrived to find an exterior transformer with smoke coming from it.

Eau Claire engine 5's officer quickly assessed the situation and extinguished the fire with a fire extinguisher. Engine 5's officer called for a second engine to check the inside of the building for an evaluation of conditions. No smoke or fire entered the building.

Fire was placed under within 10 minutes of arrival. Additional fire ground activities continued over the next hour assisting Xcel energy.

Damage to the transformer is not known at this point.

All employees returned to work as fire crews completed their assignments.
