Narrative:

The ECFD responded to a report of smoke in a building. Upon arrival the first in Engine Company noticed the entire basement was charged with smoke. The occupants of the building were dragging a mattress out of the building using the rear basement stairs. One of the occupants was evaluated by a Paramedic unit and transported to Mayo Eau Claire with non-life threatening injuries. The building was ventilated, searched for other occupants, and fire crews checked for extension of fire, none was located. There was no damage to the structure and the cause is under investigation.
