Narrative:

Eau Claire fire rescue was called by a passer by of a possible fire, they saw black smoke coming from the area of Golf and Fairfax St. On engine crew arrival they saw smoke coming from 4706 Fairfax St, an apartment building. They began evacutation of the rest of the apartments. The fire was extinguished quickly and contained to that apartment. Crews had to rescue occupants from the upper units via ladder. Fire crews also had to assist handicapped occupant from the building. The occupant of the apartment that was involved was not home at the time. There were no injuries to occupants or fire fighters as a result of the fire. Occupants were allowed to return to their apartment other than the apartment that was involved. A fire department investigator was on the scene determining the cause. At the time of the press release the cause is undetermined. Damage was estimated at about \$50,000. The property owner was on the scene securing the apartment.
