## **Narrative:**

Eau Claire Fire Rescue was called for smoke in the building at this restaurant. Apparently the store manager arrived to find smoke in the building and called 911. On the fire departments arrival there was smoke in the building and it had a smell of electrical. There was no signs of fire in the building and a crew went to the roof to investigate. A thermo imaging camera was used and found one of the two roof mounted furnaces was hot. Both units were shut off and the one that was hot was dismantled. It was found that the motor had burnt out and caused the insulation surrounding it to catch fire. The insulation was removed and extinguished. The building was ventilated of smoke. The store manager had already called a company to make repairs. The store manager indicated there would be normal store hours today. Fire department cleared and turned the store back over to the manager.
