### **Narrative:**

The Eau Claire Fire Department responded to a report of a fire in an apartment at 1025 W MacArthur Avenue. Upon fire units arrival there was no smoke or fire showing from a 2 story apartment complex. Fire crews made entry and found smoke coming from an apartment on the first floor. Fire was confined to the apartment of origin. Residents of the complex were temporary evacuated but allowed to return. No one was home at the time of the fire. Fire remains under investigation but appears to be unintentional. Fire department was assisted by the Eau Claire Police Department. Damage is estimated to be \$5500.
