## Eau Claire Fire & Rescue News Media Report



## Narrative:

At 10:15 hours the Eau Claire Fire Department was dispatched to a possible structure fire at 2615 Milward Street. The home is a wood framed, single family house.

Engine 10 arrived at 10:19 hours and found smoke coming from the rear of the house. Two attack lines were pulled and advanced into the structure. Crews found a fire in a mattress in a rear bedroom, knocked the fire down and vented the structure.

There were five people occupying the structure at the time of the fire. Prior to our arrival, one of the five occupants sustained a burn to his hand while trying to extinguish the fire. The burn was not life threatening and he was transported to Mayo Hospital in Eau Claire. The four other occupants exited the building without injury.

The fire was confined to a rear bedroom with smoke damage to the main floor, and was placed under control at 10:35. Damage is estimated at \$17,000 and is currently under investigation. The Red Cross is assisting the occupants with clothing and lodging.
