## **Narrative:**

The Eau Claire Fire Department responded to a structure fire in Banbury Place at American Phoenix . A fire was found in the #2 Banbury Mixer and extended into the ductwork. The fire went to a second alarm and some additional units called to the scene because of weather conditions. Approximately 10 firefighters were treated on scene with intravenous fluids and 1 firefighter transported to Sacred Heart Hospital for a heat related issue and was later released. The fire was brought under control within an hour. Crews remained on scene until approximately 2130 hours. Altoona Fire Department and Chippewa Fire District assisted with City of Eau Claire coverage during the fire.
