Narrative:

ECFD responded to a possible structure fire on arrival crews found light smoke in the building and sparks coming from the heating ventilation air conditioning unit on the ceiling. Crews accessed the roof to shut off the AC unit, then opened the ventilation system to find a bearing on the fan that had seized causing sparks to fall out onto the insulation. The insulation was smoldering causing the smoke. Crews removed the insulation and left the unit shut off until a repairmen could be called. Smoke had cleared out of the building with natural ventilation. There was no damage to the building.
