Narrative:

On September 22, 2016, at 01:20, the Eau Claire Fire Department was dispatched to a structure fire at 2010 Moholt Drive. Two engines, one ladder truck, one medic unit, Duty Chief, and Battalion Chief responded. En route, Battalion 1 requested a second alarm. An additional engine, medic unit, and heavy rescue unit responded. The first arriving units observed turbulent, black smoke and fire coming through the roof. A large section of the roof had collapsed. Fire department personnel immediately launched a defensive fire attack, effectively confining the fire. The fire was extinguished and thorough salvage and overhaul operations were conducted. A fire crew remains on scene to assist with the investigation and extinguishment of smoldering embers. The exact cause and origin of the fire is under investigation.
