Narrative:

At 1714, the Eau Claire Fire Department was dispatched to a report of a fire in the upstairs apartment at 1812 Kendall Street. First arriving fire units found light spoke coming from the roof at that residence. Firefighters found smoke in the upstairs apartment and fire in the ceiling. The fire was quickly extinguished. The residents were home at the time of the fire and the American Red Cross is assisting them with relocation. The fire damage is estimated to be \$35,000 to the structure and the contents. There is no report of any injuries.
