Narrative:

The City of Eau Claire Fire Department was requested to rescue two persons in the Chippewa River near the 900 Block of Forest St. The Department responded with Three rescue boats, Two Command Officers, a Rescue Squad, and a Paramedic Ambulance. Two of the rescue boats were deployed and one Firefighter entered the river wearing a cold-water rescue suit.
