




## Thermometer Calibration Log

Calibrate all thermometers at least once a week and when dropped

	<p><u>How to Calibrate a Thermometer</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Fill a glass with ice (crushed is best) and add a little water.</li> <li>2. Submerge thermometer stem.</li> <li>3. Wait a minute for temperature to adjust.</li> <li>4. If thermometer does not read 32°F when in the ice water, calibrate:       <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. If dial-use a wrench to turn the nut under the dial face until thermometer reads 32°F.</li> <li>b. If digital-see manufacturer instructions or send it to the manufacturer to calibrate.</li> </ol> </li> </ol> <p>Note: Keep the thermometer in the water when calibrating.</p>
