Narrative:

The Eau Claire Fire Department responded to the Chippewa River this afternoon on a report of two people in distress on flotation devices. The individuals were located approximately 30 feet off the river bank near the Garfield Av. area. Fire crews were able to use rescue throw ropes to bring the individuals to shore. A rescue boat, along with personnel in water rescue suits assisted during the incident. Neither individual required medical treatment.

With the river near flood stage, the conditions are extremely dangerous and recreational travel is discouraged.
