Narrative:

On July 2, @ 2353hrs, Eau Claire Fire and Rescue responded to a reported structure fire at 3642 Livingston Lane on Eau Claire's south side. Crews arrived to find smoke in the residence and garage. A fire was located in the garage and quickly extinguished. The building was ventilated to remove smoke. The investigation revealed that the cause of the fire was from an ill-aimed firework which was fired into the garage by a neighbor. The damage was estimated at \$1500. A citation was issued for a fireworks ordinance violation by the Eau Claire Police Department. TB98
