Narrative:

On August 24th, at 10:00 pm, the Eau Claire Fire Department responded to a report of a fire in the area of W Grand avenue and 5th Ave. Two engines, one aerial truck, an ambulance, and Battalion Chief responded on the first alarm. On the fire departments arrival, fire was showing from a second story window of a duplex addressed at 465 W Grand Avenue. It was not known if the residents were out of the residence. A quick search found no one was home in either apartment. A second alarm was sounded and an additional engine, ambulance and chief officer responded. The fire damage was contained to the second floor and attic but water and smoke damage was throughout the building. The fire quickly extended to the attic which made it difficult to extinguish. The fire remains under investigation and no cause is known at this time. The Eau Claire Police Department assisted at the scene. No injuries were reported.
