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## Narrative:

On November 20, 2017, at 09:47, the Eau Claire Fire Department was dispatched to a residential structure fire at 1611 Western Avenue, Lot 19. Three engines, one medic unit, Duty Chief, and Battalion Chief immediately responded. Upon arrival, the first engine company observed a fully involved mobile home. Fire crews swiftly confirmed that the occupant had evacuated and assigned the medic unit to assist the injured occupant. Fire crews immediately launched an aggressive defensive fire attack. The fire was confined and extinguished within approximately 15 minutes. Thorough salvage and overhaul operations were conducted. The occupant had sustained burns and was transported to Mayo Eau Claire Hospital. The exact cause and origin of the fire remains under investigation.
