Narrative:

The Eau Claire Fire Department responded to a reported structure fire early this morning on 4th St.

Crews arrived to find smoke showing from a second floor door and window in two-story multiple dwelling.

Fire was quickly located and extinguished in the area of a second floor jump platform with some extension to the structure.

Fire crews stopped all extending fire and overhauled the affected area while the remainder of the structure was searched for occupants and fire extension.

Occupants were allowed to return to the structure following Fire Department operations.

No injuries were reported.
