Narrative:

On February 24, 2018, at 03:44, the Eau Claire Fire Department was dispatched for a residential structure fire at 600 Graham Avenue. Two engines, one ladder truck, one medic unit, and Battalion Chief immediately responded. Upon arrival, the first arriving engine company observed light, white, smoke in the hallways of the structure. Upon entry into the structure, fire crews made contact with an Eau Claire Police Department (ECPD) officer. The ECPD officer had extinguished the fire with a fire extinguisher. Fire crews performed thorough overhaul and ventilation operations. ECPD assisted with the evacuation of the occupants. The fire was contained to the room of origin. The occupants were relocated to another apartment within the building. The exact cause and origin of the fire is currently under investigation.
