## Eau Claire Fire & Rescue News Media Report



## Narrative:

On Saturday March 24th at 0737hrs, the Eau Claire Fire Department responded to a report of a structure fire at 6426 Prairie Park Drive. On first arriving fire units arrival they found smoke and fire coming from the garage, attic and exterior of a one story duplex. Only one side of the duplex was involved in fire. All occupants had been evacuated from both sides of the duplex prior to our arrival. Crews used hand-lines and an aerial ladder truck to control the fire. Fire damage was contained to the one side of the duplex but water and smoke damage to both sides. 10 residents are displaced because of the fire and are being assisted by the American Red Cross. There were no reports of injuries to the residents or fire crews, but one cat was lost in the fire. The fire department was assisted by the Eau Claire Police Department, the Eau Claire County Communications Department, the American Red Cross, and Xcel Energy. Estimated dollar loss is \$450,000. The fire remains under investigation by The Eau Claire Fire Department.
