Narrative:

The Eau Claire Fire Department (ECFD) responded to reported structure fire at 800 Wisconsin St.

When crews arrived, building 8 was evacuated and employees reported a fire within one of their machines inside the building.

ECFD crews made entry, located the machine, and extinguished fire within the machine and adjacent ductwork. Fire crews had to dismantle portions of the machinery to achieve final extinguishment.

Nearby equipment and machinery was saved by the actions of the fire crews, who prevented any further fire extension within the building.

No injuries have been reported.
