### **Narrative:**

In the early morning hours of Saturday, December 8, the Eau Claire Fire Department was dispatched for a water rescue on Halfmoon Lake. Two engines, one truck, one boat, one medic unit, special rescue, Battalion Chief, and Duty Chief responded. Upon arrival, one victim was observed bobbing up and down in the water yelling for help. Eau Claire Fire Department personnel immediately engaged in ice/water rescue operations. Personnel entered the water and made contact with the victim. The victim was safely and swiftly removed from the water and transported to a local hospital. Eau Claire Police Department officers assisted fire crews during operations.
