Narrative:

On Monday, March 11, the Eau Claire Fire Department was dispatched to 1129 Barland Street for a structure fire. Two engines, one ladder truck, one medic unit, and a Battalion Chief responded. En route to the scene, the Communication Center notified responding units that the first floor occupants reported smoke coming from the basement. Upon arrival, fire crews observed light, white smoke coming from the basement door. Fire crews quickly confirmed that all occupants, from both the upper and lower apartments, had evacuated and immediately launched an offensive fire attack. The fire was quickly confined to the basement and extinguished. Thorough overhaul and salvage operations were conducted and the Red Cross was requested to provide assistance to the displaced occupants. At the conclusion of the incident, the property was released to the owner. The fire is currently under investigation.
