The Eau Claire Police Department has been notified that Sex Offender Brent J. McNabb Jr. (DOB: 04/12/1964) will be released from prison on August 20, 2019. McNabb will be under supervision by the Wisconsin Department of Corrections (DOC). McNabb's previous conviction include:

1st Degree Sexual Assault of a Child (May 4, 1993) - Eau Claire County

McNabb will be residing at a DOC monitored residence in the 100 block of Randall Street in the City of Eau Claire. The DOC has informed the Eau Claire Police Department this placement is temporary. DOC will work continuously to find a long-term placement for McNabb

The primary focus of McNabb's DOC release plan is to insure public safety. McNabb's conditions of release include:

- Sex offender registrant.
- Comply with all sex offender registrant rules.
- Lifetime GPS monitoring.
- No contact with juveniles.
- No use of alcohol or entering taverns.
- Allowed to leave the residence between 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. for the purpose of finding employment
