Narrative:

The Eau Claire Fire Department responded to a fire in the 1700 block of Menomonie St. this afternoon.

Fire Department crews arrived to find one exterior side of the structure on fire; that fire was immediately extinguished.

Additional fire crews performed a search of the residence and checked the structure for any fire extension. No occupants were present at the time of the fire, and no fire extension was found.

The residence was ventilated and checked with meters to assure appropriate air quality.

The ECPD was on scene and assisted throughout the incident, which included removing a pet from the residence.
