Narrative:

On Sunday October 20, at 23:09hrs, the Eau Claire Fire Department responded to a structure fire at 5576 Normandale Dr on the cities westside. Upon fire unit's arrival, the crews found a working fire in the kitchen of a single-story residential duplex. Fire extended from the kitchen into the attic. Crews worked quickly to contain the fire to one unit and the attic. The fire was brought under control within 40 minutes. 2 engines, 2 ladder trucks, 1 squad, 2 ambulances, and 2 chiefs responded to the call. There were no reported injuries. The fire remains under investigation. The fire department was assisted by the Eau Claire Police Department, and Xcel energy.
