## Changes to Absentee Voting

EAU CLAIRE, WI – The following requirements for Absentee Ballots by Mail for the April 7 Election have been changed to:

- Voters have until 5 p.m. on Friday, April 3<sup>rd</sup>, to request that their municipal clerk mail an absentee ballot to them.
- Voters have until 4 p.m. on Monday, April 13<sup>th</sup>, to return absentee ballots to their municipal clerk.
- The witness signature requirement on the absentee envelope is lifted only if the absentee voter provides a written affirmation or other statement with the ballot that they were unable to safely obtain a witness signature despite reasonable efforts to do so, provided the ballots are otherwise valid.
