

How to Request an E-Inspection

What is an electronic inspection or e-Inspection?

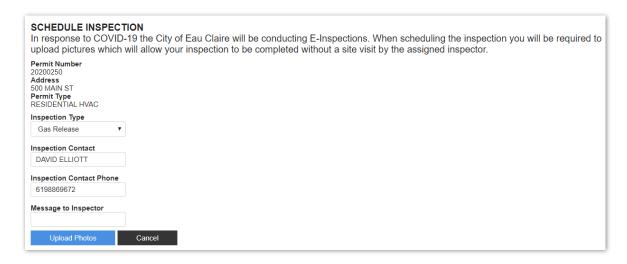
An e-Inspection is an inspection that may not require an inspector to visit the job site. Photos of the completed work are sent to the inspector for review. Only certain types of inspections may qualify for an e-inspection and the inspector may require a site inspection after reviewing your photos.

How do I request an e-inspection?

Login to the Permit Portal at https://evolvepublic.infovisionsoftware.com/eauclaire/ as usual. Click on My Permits to see your list of permits.

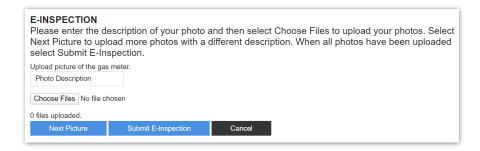


Select Request Inspection and choose the inspection type.



You can now enter a message to the inspector with notes if you wish. Select Upload Photos to upload pictures of the completed work.





Enter a description of the photo(s) you will be uploading then select Choose Files to select your photos. Use Next Picture to upload a new group of photos with a different description. Select Submit e-Inspection when finished.

The inspector will now review your request.

How do I check the status of an e-Inspection?

You can check the status of your e-Inspection in the same manner as you would a normal inspection. Inspection results will be sent to you through your selected method of contact (email/text). You can also view inspection results on the Permit Portal online under My Permits.
