# Children ages 12-15 are now eligible for the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine

**Eau Claire, WI, May 13, 2021** – Beginning today, children 12-15 years old are now eligible to receive the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine. In Eau Claire County, this means an additional ~4,000 people will be now eligible for vaccination. The Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine requires two doses for full protection and is the first and only vaccine available for this age group.

After successful clinical trials and a rigorous review of all available data, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) authorized Pfizer's request to expand the emergency use authorization (EUA) to include adolescents ages 12-15. On Wednesday, May 12, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC) Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) confirmed the vaccine is safe and voted to recommend the vaccine to the age group.

"This is another step forward to increase the number of people who are protected from COVID-19. Clinical trials have shown the vaccine is safe and effective at preventing COVID-19 in 12-15 year olds," says Lieske Giese, Health Department Director.

## Where can my child get Pfizer vaccine?
