Health Dept Seeks Dog that Bit Female

Eau Claire, WI, June 1st, 2021 – The Eau Claire City-County Health Department is seeking assistance in locating a dog that bit a woman, Monday, May 24th, 2021, at approximately 10:30 p.m. The bite occurred on the 1000 block of W. Hamilton Avenue.

The dog was described as a medium sized terrier type breed with short, white hair. The dog was on a leash walking with a female described to be in her mid 30's with blonde hair, and about 5'5".

The health and rabies status of this dog needs to be determined. If anyone has information about this animal they should contact the Eau Claire Communications Center at 715-839-4972.
