NARRATIVE:

On Saturday July 24, 2021, at approximately 1038 hrs. the Eau Claire Fire Department responded to 3635 N Hastings Way for a report of a 1st alarm structure fire. Battalion 1 and Engine 8 were the first to arrive on scene. They reported smoke coming from the eaves and smoke staining around the windows and doors of a detached garage / shop. E8's Crew worked quickly to search and contain the fire. The fire was brought under control in approximately 30 minutes. Three Engines, one Ladder Truck, one Ambulance, one fire inspector and two Chiefs responded to the call. There were no reported injuries. The fire remains under investigation.
