## **Health Dept Seeks Dog that Bit Male**

**Eau Claire, WI, October 19<sup>th</sup> , 2021** – The Eau Claire City-County Health Department is seeking assistance in locating a dog that bit a male, Saturday, October 16<sup>th</sup>, 2021, at approximately 11:00 a.m. The bite occurred on the Water Street bridge.

The dog was described as a medium sized, black pit bull type breed. The dog was on a leash being walked by a black male described to be in his mid-20's, approximately 5' 10", wearing a bright green John Deere hat, dark colored sweatshirt, and red pants. The male with the dog was walking westbound on Water Street.
