PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that members of the City Council of the City of Eau Claire have been invited and may be in attendance at a League of Wisconsin Municipalities (LWM) and Congress for the New Urbanism (CNU) training on how to use the ***Zoning Guide for Affordable Housing*** on Monday, February 21, 2022, beginning at 9 a.m. at Holiday Inn South, 4751 Owen Ayres Court, Eau Claire, Wisconsin.

CNU faculty is providing training for municipal elected officials and others interested in using the Guide. The Guide will be available for download in mid-February. Background is available through Director of Community Development Scott Allen at 715-839-4914. Sessions will focus on the methodology of incremental code reform and the process and implementation described within the new Guide. The training will cover how to use the documents in the Guide, navigating the steps to amending a code, and determining where to start. The overall goal of the Guide and the training is to show that bite-sized zoning code changes are possible and can have an immediate impact on removing obstacles to the development of workforce and missing middle housing.
