NARRATIVE:

The Eau Claire Fire Department was dispatched to a report of a structure fire located at 209 Sara St at 3:30pm today. ECFD was the first to arrive on location and advised dispatch it was a working fire and the occupants were reported to be out of the home. On arrival, ECFD crews reported a single story, single family residential structure with fire and smoke showing from the attic near the rear of the structure. While crews conducted searches, the fire was quickly brought under control and extinguished. Crews continued to check for fire extension and perform salvage operations. ECFD Inspectors worked to conduct a scene investigation. ECFD responded with three engines, one truck, one ambulance, two chiefs and two inspectors. ECFD was assisted by, Eau Claire Police, Eau Claire Communications Center, and Xcel Energy. No injuries were reported at the time of this report. Battalion Chief Brian Toonen
