The applicant agrees that the art shall be repainted or reapplied within 60 days of written notice by the city, at applicant's sole expense.		
The city may remove, alter, reconstruct or relocate any public art, or require the applicant to do so, as it may		
deem necessary at the time and at the applicant's sole expense.		
The applicant acknowledges that if approved, any public art needs to be reapproved or removed at the end of		
the term.		
The applicant has reviewed Chapter 9.76.230 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Eau Claire (Appendix 2) and agrees to abide by those regulations.		
The applicant acknowledges that the City shall not be liable or responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any		
property of the artist resulting from any cause whatsoever, including but not limited to theft and vandalism.		
The applicant agrees to hold harmless and indemnify the City of Eau Claire, its officers, agents, and employees		
for any and all types of claims, actions, or expenses arising from the art caused by construction, operation or		
maintenance of such public art; and agrees to defend the City, its officers, agents and employees, at no cost to		
the City should any claim or action be asserted.
