Eau Claire Police Investigate Shooting

On September 17, 2022 at12:12 AM, Eau Claire Police Officers responded to the intersection of Bergen Avenue/Bellevue Avenue for a report of multiple gunshots in a residential neighborhood.

Upon arrival, Officers located a male subject with a gunshot wound. Officers immediately provided medical aid until the Eau Claire Fire Department transported to a local hospital. The male subject was later pronounced deceased at the hospital. An autopsy will be conducted by a forensic pathologist at Ramsey Medical Center in St. Paul, MN. The name of the victim will not be released at this time.

Members of the Eau Claire Police Department processed the crime scene with the assistance of the Wisconsin State Patrol. Detectives are conducting interviews with neighboring residents and reviewing surveillance video. Based on the initial investigation this appears to be an isolated incident and the public is not in any danger.

During the course of the investigation a person of interest was identified. That person was later taken into custody.
