

Development Requirements

Proposed housing developments follow a review process based on use type (one- or two-family, 3-8 units, 9+ units, community based residential facilities, fraternity or sorority, manufactured homes, or rooming house). Each use has different development requirements determined by Federal and State Law, Building and Safety Codes, and standards found in the Municipal Code.

Goals in the Comprehensive Plan must be reflected in the Municipal Code to impact on the ground development.
