NARRATIVE:

Eau Claire Fire Department responded to a water flow alarm this morning at 800 Wisconsin St, Banbury Place. Upon arrival, Engine Company No. 10 reported a working fire in the business American Phoenix and requested a 1st Alarm assignment. Two Engine Companies, Two Truck Companies, One medic unit, One Inspector, a Heavy Rescue and Two Chiefs responded. Engine Co. 10 reported the fire was confined to a trash compactor and a fast attack brought the fire under control quickly. Crews checked for extension on the upper floors and reported none. ECFD inspector was on location and is leading the investigation.

Fast confinement and containment of the fire can be attributed to the aid of a working sprinkler system. There were no reported injuries and Eau Claire FD was assisted by Eau Claire PD and the Eau Claire Communication Center.
