NARRATIVE:

On Tuesday December 27, at approximately 0233 hrs. the Eau Claire Fire Department responded to 5707 Christopher Dr. for a report of a structure fire. Upon arrival, Engine Co 9 found a working fire in a single-story residential duplex. Crews worked quickly to search both sides of the duplex while conducting fire attack. The fire was quickly brought under control. Fire extension and damage was limited to one side of the duplex. One pet cat was found decease. A first alarm assignment of 3 Engines, 1 Ladder Truck, 1 Ambulance, 2 Chiefs and 1 Fire Inspector responded to the call. The fire remains under investigation. The fire department was assisted by the Eau Claire Communications Center and Eau Claire Police Department. No injuries were reported and the fire remains under investigation.
